Steps into Christ

*"We walk by faith,
not by sight" 2 Cor 5:7*

The Christian life is a continuous walk of faith. In order to be saved & become a Christian, there are certain things a person needs to do; everything done in that process of becoming a Christian is also a new step of faith!

STEP 1. HEAR THE TRUTH

The Gospel or 'Good News' is *"the power of God unto salvation"*. But in order for us to hear the truth of the Gospel, it must be preached & Jesus commanded us to *"preach the Gospel to all"*. No-one can be saved unless they hear this Good News! (Rom 1:16; Rom 10:14,17; Mark 16:15)

STEP 2. BELIEVE IN CHRIST

The word 'believe' is a verb or an action word. And it means *"to put confidence in", "to trust" or "to have faith in"*. The Bible says *"without faith, it is impossible to please God."* This is not just "head-faith", but "active faith". Faith that saves is the faith that obeys. (Heb 11:6; Rom 10:17; James 2:24)

STEP 3. REPENT OF SINS

Jesus said, *"But unless you repent, you too will all perish."* Repentance is the natural & logical reaction of faith. It is not only feeling sorry for past actions; it is the act of turning away from sin & it first takes place in the heart. *God's kindness is what leads us to repentance."* A new degree of faith also comes after repentance! (Luke 13:3,5; Acts 17:30; Rom 2:4, 2 Cor 7:10)

STEP 4. CONFESS FAITH IN CHRIST

Confession is an important & significant part of salvation. To confess is *"to admit or declare as truth."* It is the outward & public declaration of the inward revelation. God's Word says, *"If you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord & believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved!" Rom 10:9.* In the Bible, there are a examples of people who rose to a new level of faith when they confessed their faith in Jesus!
*Peter (Mathew 16:16-17; Luke 9: 18-20)
*Timothy (1 Tim 6:12) *The Ethiopian eunuch (Acts 8:36-37)

STEP 5. BE BAPTIZED

Baptism is a significant part of our salvation. Jesus Himself commanded His disciples to *"Go and make disciples of all nations, baptising them in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit..."* (Mathew 28:18-20). God chose baptism as a dynamic way of symbolizing our identification with Jesus' death, burial & resurrection—
"Therefore we are buried with Him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life" (Romans 6:4).
